
Texas SB 212 Board of Trustees Report Fall 2019, Spring 2020, and Summer 2020¹

- 1. Texas SB 212 requires that the University's "Chief Executive Officer" (i.e., Chancellor) create a report detailing:
 - The number of mandatory reports received;
 - Number of investigations conducted as a result of those reports;
 - Number of those reports for which the University determined not to initiate a disciplinary process, if any.



*In Fall 2019, there were no Mandatory Reported Cases which resulted in an investigation.

¹ Fall 2019 = August 15, 2019 – December 31, 2019; Spring 2020 = January 1, 2020 – May 15, 2020; Summer 2020 = May 16, 2020 – August 14, 2020.

- 2. Additionally, TX SB 212 requires that the institution report the disposition, if any, of disciplinary processes arising from those reports.
 - Fall 2019: No sanctions were administered as a result of a mandatory report and subsequent investigation.
 - Spring 2020:
 - 1 case of Sexual Assault resulted in a 1-year suspension from TCU; Respondent not allowed to live on campus upon return; Respondent required to meet with Confidential Advocate within 1 week of returning to campus.
 - 1 case of Dating Violence resulted in a 1-year suspension; Respondent not allowed to live on campus; and Respondent required to attend gun safety course and show certificate of completion
 - Summer 2020²: 1 case of Stalking pending finalization of disciplinary process and determination of responsibility.
- 3. Finally, TX SB 212 requires that the institution report any disciplinary action taken against a TCU employee for failing to make a mandatory report for cases involving Sexual Harassment, Sexual Assault, Dating/Domestic Violence, and Stalking.

As for October 6, 2020; no TCU employee in the three reporting time periods (i.e., Fall 2019; Spring 2020; and Summer 2020) have not been disciplined for failure to mandatory report. The University is unaware of any employee who failed to report a case involving Sexual Harassment, Sexual Assault, Dating/Domestic Violence, and Stalking.

² During the Summer 2020 reporting time period, as of October 6, 2020, there is a single case resulting in an investigation that has not completed the disciplinary process. Sanctions will be determined upon determination of responsibility.
